### **John 4:21-24** New King James Version (NKJV)

*<sup>21</sup> Jesus said to her, "Woman, believe Me, the hour is coming when you will neither on this mountain, nor in Jerusalem, worship the Father. <sup>22</sup> You worship what you do not know; we know what we worship, for salvation is of the Jews. <sup>23</sup> But the hour is coming, and now is, when the true worshipers will worship the Father in spirit and truth; for the Father is seeking such to worship Him. <sup>24</sup> God is Spirit, and those who worship Him must worship in spirit and truth."*

God is Spirit and He seeks those who must worship Him in spirit and truth. Astonishingly, most of us alive today are ignorant of the fact that we all have a small part of the mighty God dwelling in us. The composition of man is spirit, soul and body. The spirit that gives life to the soul and body is a small part of God. We are supposed to keep that spirit clean by obeying the laws and commandments of God and live by faith. ### **1 John 3:4-6** New King James Version (NKJV)

*<sup>4</sup> Whoever commits sin also commits lawlessness, and sin is lawlessness. <sup>5</sup> And you know that He was manifested to take away our sins, and in Him there is no sin. <sup>6</sup> Whoever abides in Him does not sin. Whoever sins has neither seen Him nor known Him.*

God had already said every soul belongs to Him and the soul that sins shall die. We all have an appointment with death, but assuredly, God has promised a resurrection into eternal life for all those who repent of their sins. We don't want to be part of the Great White Throne Judgement. Everyone, who does not repent of their sins, will face judgement at an appointed time in the future:

### **Ezekiel 18:4** New King James Version (NKJV)

*<sup>4</sup> "Behold, all souls are Mine; The soul of the father As well as the soul of the son is Mine; The soul who sins shall die.*

The root cause of all our tribulations and anguish on earth today is sin. Regardless of what we believe, if we could totally eradicate sin from the earth today, all our anguish and tribulations will also pass away. But many will not turn from their wicked ways, even if the Lord pleads with them face to face. We have been given an opportunity to live forever in peace and prosperity. All we must do is repent of our sins and start living in obedience to God's laws and commandments. Some will ask what connection has sin with the coronavirus? It has everything to do with it. The earth is about to reject its inhabitants because the sins of its inhabitants is weighing heavy on it. We have defiled the land with our abominations as our forefathers did in the past:

### **Leviticus 18:24-30** New King James Version (NKJV)

*<sup>24</sup> 'Do not defile yourselves with any of these things; for by all these the nations are defiled, which I am casting out before you. <sup>25</sup> For the land is defiled; therefore I visit the punishment of its iniquity upon it, and the land vomits out its inhabitants. <sup>26</sup> You shall therefore keep My statutes and My judgments, and shall not commit any of these abominations, either any of your own nation or any stranger who dwells among you <sup>27</sup> (for all these abominations the men of the land have done, who were before you, and thus the land is defiled), <sup>28</sup> lest the land vomit you out also when you defile it, as it vomited out the nations that were before you. <sup>29</sup> For whoever commits any of these abominations, the persons who commit them shall be cut off from among their people.*

*<sup>30</sup> 'Therefore you shall keep My ordinance, so that you do not commit any of these abominable customs which were committed before you, and that you do not defile yourselves by them: I am the LORD your God.' "*

The previous verses of this chapter outlines some of the abominations that defiled the land, bloodshed is one of them. The apostle Paul was inspired to write, emphasising the fact that all men everywhere have been called to repentance, which therefore includes the whole world. We must remember that the Lord compared our generation to that of the days of

Noah and Lot. Before we go any further, we must seriously consider what the Lord our God has said:

### **Isaiah 45:5-7** New King James Version (NKJV)

*<sup>5</sup> I am the LORD, and there is no other; There is no God besides Me. I will gird you, though you have not known Me, <sup>6</sup> That they may know from the rising of the sun to its setting That there is none besides Me. I am the LORD, and there is no other; <sup>7</sup> I form the light and create darkness, I make peace and create calamity; I, the LORD, do all these things.*

There is only one God and one truth. Nothing happens here on the earth without the Lord's knowledge and as we have just seen, it is the Lord our God who makes peace and creates calamity. In the book of the prophet Amos, we are given more information about what God means. We must understand that these are not the words of the prophet Amos. These are the words of God. The prophet Amos is not capable of bringing calamity in a city, but God can do whatever pleases Him:

### **Amos 3:5-8** New King James Version (NKJV)

*<sup>5</sup> Will a bird fall into a snare on the earth, where there is no trap for it? Will a snare spring up from the earth, if it has caught nothing at all? <sup>6</sup> If a trumpet is blown in a city, will not the people be afraid? If there is calamity in a city, will not the LORD have done it? <sup>7</sup> Surely the Lord GOD does nothing, Unless He reveals His secret to His servants the prophets. <sup>8</sup> A lion has roared! Who will not fear? The Lord GOD has spoken! Who can but prophesy?*

The Lord qualified what He wants us to understand by giving us simple earthly examples before saying if there is calamity in a city, will not the Lord have done it. We should be under no illusion of the fact that what is happening on earth today has been authorised by the Lord for good reasons. Consider this passage of Scripture:

### **Matthew 28:18-20** New King James Version (NKJV)

*<sup>18</sup> And Jesus came and spoke to them, saying, "All authority has been given to Me in heaven and on earth. <sup>19</sup> Go therefore and make disciples of all the nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, <sup>20</sup> teaching them to observe all things that I have commanded you; and lo, I am with you always, even to the end of the age." Amen.*

### **Amos 4:6-13** New King James Version (NKJV)

<sup>6</sup> *"Also I gave you cleanness of teeth in all your cities, And lack of bread in all your places; Yet you have not returned to Me," Says the LORD. <sup>7</sup> "I also withheld rain from you, When there were still three months to the harvest. I made it rain on one city, I withheld rain from another city. One part was rained upon, And where it did not rain the part withered. <sup>8</sup> So two or three cities wandered to another city to drink water, But they were not satisfied; Yet you have not returned to Me," Says the LORD.*

<sup>9</sup> *"I blasted you with blight and mildew. When your gardens increased, Your vineyards, Your fig trees, And your olive trees, The locust devoured them; Yet you have not returned to Me," Says the LORD.*

<sup>10</sup> *"I sent among you a plague after the manner of Egypt; Your young men I killed with a sword, Along with your captive horses; I made the stench of your camps come up into your nostrils; Yet you have not returned to Me," Says the LORD.*

<sup>11</sup> *"I overthrew some of you, As God overthrew Sodom and Gomorrah, And you were like a firebrand plucked from the burning; Yet you have not returned to Me," Says the LORD.*

<sup>12</sup> *"Therefore thus will I do to you, O Israel; Because I will do this to you, Prepare to meet your God, O Israel!"*

<sup>13</sup> *For behold, He who forms mountains, And creates the wind, Who declares to man what his thought is, And makes the morning darkness, Who treads the high places of the earth— The LORD God of hosts is His name.*

### **Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 New King James Version (NKJV)**

*<sup>13</sup>Let us hear the conclusion of the whole matter: Fear God and keep His commandments, For this is man's all. <sup>14</sup>For God will bring every work into judgment, Including every secret thing, Whether good or evil.*

Fear God and keep His commandments, for this is the whole duty of man. We have been brought to our knees throughout the world to keep us quiet, so we can find out the truth about life. Make good use of this time because what is to come is totally dreadful. Don't be deceived.
